Access to Genetic Resources and Fair and equitable sharing of benefits derived from their use

Background

- 1. The last Forum of Ministers decided to establish six working groups which were open to all the countries of the region, subject to the fulfilment of paragraph 4 of decision 4 (Functioning of the Working Groups): a) Environmental Indicators; b) Risk Management; c) Access to Genetic Resources; d) Climate Change; e) Management of Coastal-Marine Areas and their Resources; and f) Environmental Education for Sustainable Development.
- 2. Four working groups established, in line with the decision, specific activities to be developed during the biennium. After making the pertinent consultations with the countries, several calls, communications and exchanges with the coordinating countries, the Working Groups that continue to function are: Access to Genetic Resources, Climate Change, Environmental Education for Sustainable Development, and Environmental Indicators.
- 3. Since the last Forum of Ministers these groups have held meetings to progress in the implementation of their programmes with the coordination of the country coordinators and support of the Secretariat of the Forum. Final reports of the most recent meetings of the Environmental Indicators Working Group (Heredia Costa Rica, 26 to 28 August 2009), and the Working Group on Access to Genetic Resources and Sharing of Benefits derived from their use (Panama City, Panama 15 and 16 January 2010) to the Forum of Ministers, are available as reference documents for this meeting, UNEP/LAC/IGWG.XVII/Ref.5 and UNEP/LAC/IGWG.XVII/Ref.7 respectively.
- 4. These two groups which are under the coordination of Costa Rica, in the case of Environmental Indicators, and Ecuador, in the case of Access to Genetic Resources and Sharing of Benefits derived from their use, have presented to the Secretariat their plan of work for the biennium 2010-2011, which are described hereafter.

ILAC WGEI Work Plan 2010-2011

1. Working Group on Environmental Indicators (WGEI)

- Continue with the activities of the Forum's Working Group on Environmental Indicators in order to strengthen and consolidate activities related to environmental indicators
- Continue the work of the Technical Advisory Committee in order to incorporate the Geospatial Information and Earth Observation Systems in the WGEI activities, and in the elaboration of the ILAC indicators.
- Strengthen and promote complementarities and synergies between the Statistical Conference of the Americas (SCA) Working Group on Environmental Statistics and the ILAC Working Group on Environmental Indicators (WGEI) work plans and with that of other regional and sub-regional organizations in order to advance in the development of environmental statistics.
- Consider the possibility of rotating the coordination of the Working Group among the WGEI member countries as a mechanism to drive horizontal cooperation, for consideration of the Forum. This Group will focus its activities for the period 2010-2011 on the following areas:
