
Replenishment of the Multilateral Fund

- Proposal by Federated States of Micronesia


Other issues considered by the 34th OEWG and on agenda of the 26th MOP agenda

- Information submitted by Parties on their implementation of paragraph 9 of decision XIX/6 to promote a transition from ozone-depleting substances that minimizes environmental impact (decision XXV/5, paragraph 3)
